EIGHT NEW CERTIFIED NURSING ASSISTANTS GRADUATE AT THREE PILLARS WITH WCTC

May 13, 2019 — Eight new Certified Nursing Assistants recently completed a rigorous 12-week training course led by Waukesha County Technical College onsite at Three Pillars Senior Living Communities.
