

The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) continues to update their guidance. It is important to note that this guidance applies to our regulated communities: Compass Point, Riverside Lodge, and the Masonic Center for Health and Rehab. Three Pillars develops guidelines to also apply at Village on the Square when applicable to keep our residents and staff safe.

It can be complex to understand the requirements in group settings, like our campus, so this document is intended to clarify for each building and setting.

We encourage all individuals, regardless of vaccination status, to wash their hands/sanitize regularly. Please DO NOT participate in anything on campus if you are not feeling well.

This is what the CDC's terms "up to date" and "not up to date" mean for COVID-19 vaccination status:

The following charts describe various activities and settings, along with the required prevention measures required. This is not intended to cover every situation.

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At CP, MCHR, and RSL:

- In indoor public spaces, all employees, visitors, and vendors must wear a mask at all times and face shield/goggles (when indicated).
- While some scenarios, such as a visit with a resident in a private space, do not require masking or distancing, please always have the mask we provide upon entry in case the need arises to wear one.
- If any building is in Outbreak Status, residents may not attend indoor activities with other buildings. They may attend outdoor activities with other buildings, as long as social distancing is followed.

At VOS:

- In indoor public spaces, all employees and vendors must wear a mask at all times.
- For residents and visitors who are up to date on vaccinations, masks are optional.
- For residents and visitors who are not up to date on vaccinations, masks are required in common areas.
- While some scenarios, such as a visit with a resident in a private space, do not require masking or distancing, please always have the mask we provide upon entry in case the need arises to wear one.

TYPE OF INTERACTION	ONLY IF ALL PARTICIPANTS UP TO DATE ON VACCINATIONS	IF 1+ ARE NOT UP TO DATE ON VACCINATIONS or UNKNOWN STATUS
Riding in group transportation provided by Three Pillars for an outing.		Residents who are not up to date on vaccines may not attend at this time
Riding in transportation provided by Three Pillars for an individual appointment.		 Our largest vehicle will be used to allow for distancing
Going into public indoor places on outings (restaurants, shopping centers, theaters, museums).		

INDOOR ACTIVITIES DINING		
TYPE OF INTERACTION	ONLY IF ALL PARTICIPANTS UP TO DATE ON VACCINATIONS	IF 1+ ARE NOT UP TO DATE ON VACCINATIONS or UNKNOWN STATUS
Go to the Wellness Connection		The Wellness Connection is open to those up to date on their COVID-19 vaccination.
Go to Beauty Shop and/or Barber at Three Pillars.		

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INDOOR ACTIVITIES DINING		
TYPE OF INTERACTION	ONLY IF ALL PARTICIPANTS UP TO DATE ON VACCINATIONS	IF 1+ ARE NOT UP TO DATE ON VACCINATIONS or UNKNOWN STATUS
Dine together in Three Pillars' dining rooms.		
Attend indoor events and activities at Three Pillars, including worship service, fitness classes, and Recreation/Lifestyles programs.		
<i>Residents:</i> Participate in functions across campus. (In a building other than your own).		

OUTDOOR ACTIVITIES		
TYPE OF INTERACTION	ONLY IF ALL PARTICIPANTS UP TO DATE ON VACCINATIONS	IF 1+ ARE NOT UP TO DATE ON VACCINATIONS or UNKNOWN STATUS
Walk, run, or bike, or visit outdoors with others.		
Attend outdoor event on Three Pillars' campus, such as an outdoor concert or group activity.		

For Volunteers and Employees of Three Pillars:

- All volunteers must be up to date on vaccines
- All employees must follow vaccination mandate or have an exemption for the building they work in
- **Testing Requirements:**
 - When any building on campus is in Outbreak Status, all staff from that building must test twice per week
 - Up to date employees from any building – *testing is optional when not in Outbreak Status*
 - Not up to date employees from any building – *test twice per week*
 - New employees must test twice per week for their first 30 days of employment (mandatory) and then follow their vaccination status testing requirements
 - Testing Clinic Schedule at the Wellness Connection:
Monday and Friday | 5:30 AM – 9:00 AM and 1:30 PM – 5:00 PM
