RE: Visitation Updates - Indoors and Outdoors

Based on new guidance from Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS), we are happy to announce a few changes to our indoor and outdoor visitation policy during COVID-19. Please refer to the attached policy for all the details.

We want to make this as easy as possible. Here are some reminders of what you need to do to help us maintain this policy.

- Always use Sign-Up Genius to schedule your indoor and outdoor visits: <http://bit.ly/3PVisits>
- First time visitors should fill out the Informed Consent & Assumption of Risk form. It can be found on Sign Up Genius, Three Pillars' website, or in the folder in the main entrance vestibule.
- All visitors must be screened in at the kiosk in the vestibule prior to each visit.
- Updates to the policy since we last sent a communication include:
 - When a resident is fully vaccinated (over 2 weeks past the last vaccine in the series), physical contact will be allowed as long as both parties are wearing a mask.
 - Outdoor visits are open and are not limited to dedicated days and times.
 - Face shields are only required when county positivity rates indicate. Signs in the vestibule will indicate if they are needed on a daily basis.

Three Pillars will continue to monitor the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC), Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS), and Department of Health and Human Services (DHS) recommendations and implement their suggestions for Health Care settings.
