

Three Pillars Named the Only Best Continuing Care Retirement Community in Wisconsin for 2023-24

U.S. News & World Report released a new list of "Best" communities in their <u>Best Senior</u> <u>Living</u> program. In its inaugural year, the program saw <u>1,274 communities</u> recognized, and that number climbs to 1,675 for 2023-24.

- The program includes independent living, assisted living, memory care, and continuing care retirement/life plan communities.
- Rankings came after analyzing data from more than 250,000 resident and family member surveys at 3,867 communities.
- To earn "Best" status, communities had to earn a specific final weighted score according to the US News health data analytics team.



Three Pillars Senior Living Communities earned a "Best" rating for Independent Living and Assisted Living. These accolades, combined with Three Pillars' existing "Best-ranked," long-term-care skilled nursing and short-term rehabilitation, earned the community a Best Continuing Care Retirement Community ranking, as well. Only 59 communities in the nation met this narrow definition.

Only 43 percent of the nearly 4,000 communities U.S. News evaluated earned a "Best" rating for even one type of care. Three
