



FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

When will the race happen?

Saturday, September 19, 2026, during Three Pillars Fest, which runs from 11am - 3pm. At 2:30pm the ducks will launch from the Three Pillars Footbridge into the untamed waters of the Bark River.

Do I need to be at the race to win?

No. You don't need to be at the race to win. We'll contact you by phone or email if the duck number corresponding to your raffle ticket crosses the finish line first, second or third!

Is there a limit to the number of tickets I can buy?

No. You can buy as many tickets as you would like; there are 2,000 available.

Can I pay with a credit card?

Yes! You can buy online through the dedicated website [here](#)!

Can I purchase tickets in person with cash?

Sure, just stop by the Three Pillars Development Office at 314 E Village Ct, C Wing, weekdays between 8am - 4:30pm. Or look for the Masons selling tickets during select days and times.

Do I actually take possession of my duck?

No. These ducks are a special, weighted variety for racing. All the ducks are individually numbered, and that number corresponds to your ticket number. Be sure to fill out your name, phone number and email address on the ticket stub so we can contact you if your duck wins!

What if the ducks get caught in the weeds?

The ducks are not allowed to be interfered with once they enter the water. We'll have designated people in the water to grab any wayward ducks after the race ends.

Where does the money go?

100% of the proceeds will support the Resident Support Fund at Three Pillars and the Glenn L Humphrey Lodge Scholarship Fund.

What if it rains?

If weather conditions prevent us from holding the duck race in the river, we'll ensure the fun continues! All raffle tickets will be placed into a bin, and we'll randomly draw 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place winners to keep the excitement—and prizes—afloat.

And, yes, you can win more than once!

Three Pillars has a raffle license to run this duck race and will follow the raffle guidelines provided by the State of Wisconsin Department of Administration Gaming.
