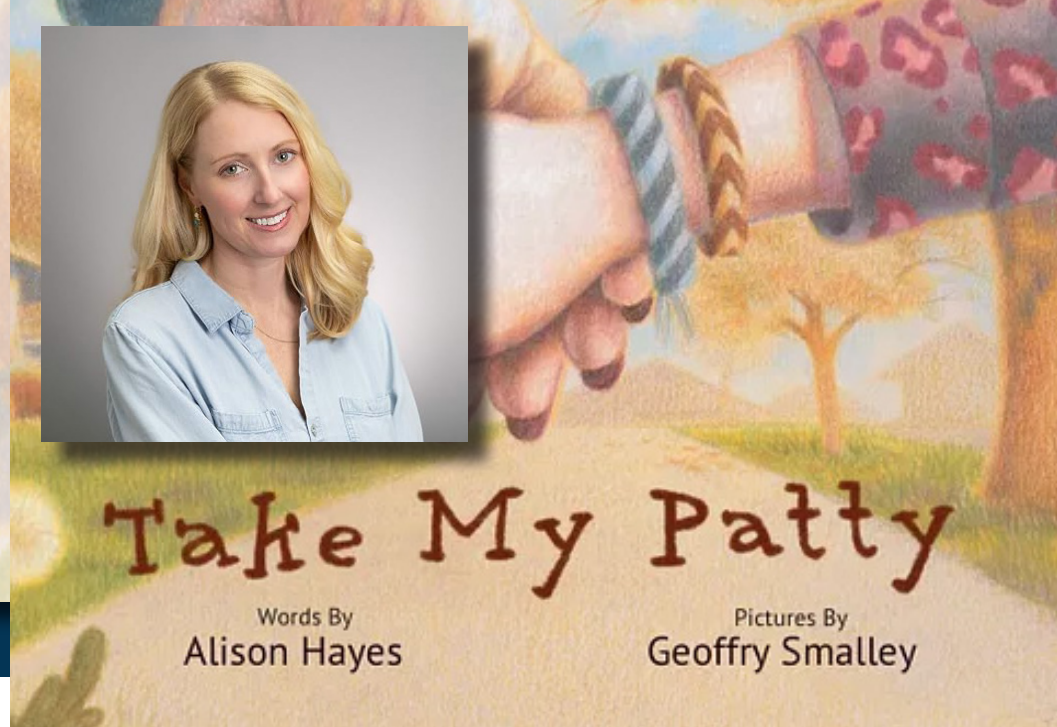


Meet the Author – Alison Hayes
